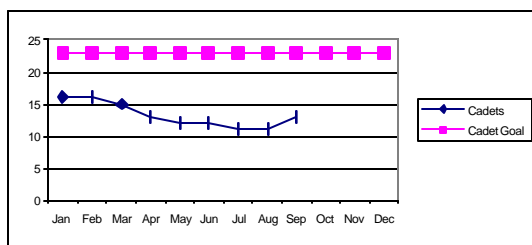

The Garber Award is awarded when a member has completed all Level IV requirements in the senior member training program. The emphasis of this portion of the program is management of the units larger than a squadron.

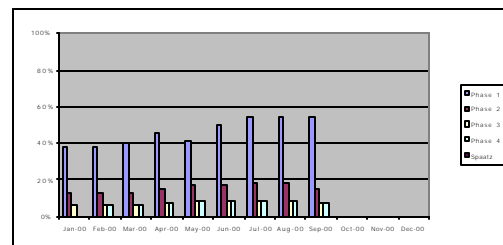
The Loening Award is awarded when a member has completed all Level III requirements in the senior member training program. The emphasis of this portion of the program is management of the squadron.

Where do we stand at the moment?

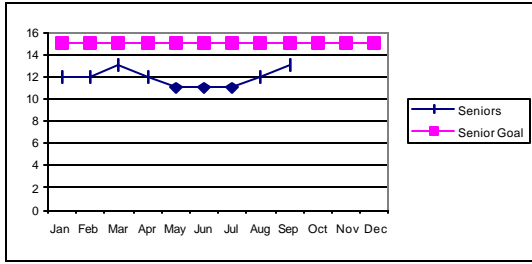
These next couple of charts will show you where we stand in regards to cadets, senior members, and a squadron as a whole. As you can see, we are turning the corner and moving upward.



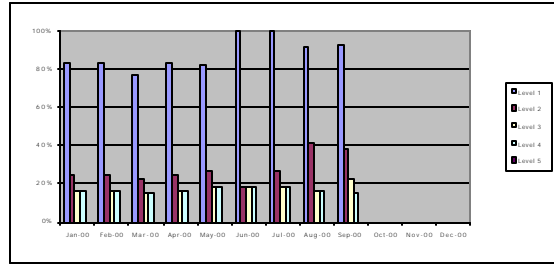
Cadet Recruiting



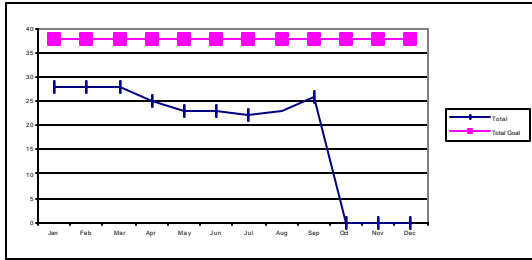
Cadet Progression
